

‘Many pages missing from suicide note’

SALEM: Family members of R. Vishnupriya told *The Hindu* that many pages in the suicide note she left behind were missing and they demanded that her mobile phone and laptop be handed over.

“Since senior officials are involved, only a CBI inquiry would bring out the truth,” they added.

Vishnupriya’s father refused to sign the documents for autopsy claiming that she ended her life due to mental torture by the Namakkal SP and also because of threats from Yuvaraj, the main accused in the Gokulraj murder case.. When Police Commissioner A. Amalraj told the family that the post-mortem would be done only under the existing rules, they permitted the autopsy.
