

# M. G. Ramachandran Operated on Again

MADRAS, March 23.

Mr. M. G. Ramachandran, film actor, to-day, underwent an operation at the General Hospital, here, when doctors removed the bullet embedded in his neck.

Mr. Ramachandran was admitted in the hospital yesterday after he had complained of a pain in the neck. Subsequent X-Ray examinations revealed that the bullet had moved away from its original position and the doctors decided on an operation to remove it.

Mr. Ramachandran was admitted in the hospital earlier on January 12, with bullet wounds sustained in an incident at his residence that day. At that time, the doctors found the bullet lodged behind the first vertebra and did not attempt to disturb it.

Mr. Ramachandran was to-day reported to be out of danger. After the operation, he is stated to have told his relatives that he was doing well.

Mr. M. R. Radha, another film actor, is facing trial on a charge of attempting to murder Mr. Ramachandran.
